When Do We Leave?

Monday, July 4

When Do We Return?

Saturday, July 9
We will arrive back at FCC early in the afternoon. Students will text parents when 1 hour away.

What Is The Cost?

This trip costs \$425. That includes all meals (except 4 fast food meals on the road), transportation, programming, lodging and any supplies needed for small groups. You will need to bring extra money for souvenirs, 4 fast food meals, any gas station/coffee stops and if you would like to give to the missions' offering.

Important Dates:

- **December 1**, Registration Opens. CIY has sold this trip out, so when all reserved spots are taken, there is no available waiting list. Availability is first come, first served. **Your spot is held with a nonrefundable \$65 deposit and completed registration form.**
- **February 16**, deposit #2 of \$65 is due.
- **May 4**, final trip balances are due.
- **July 4-9**, the TRIP!

*****Note:** Regardless of participation, registered students are financially responsible if they drop out on or after **May 4, 2022**.

Fundraising: We will be fundraising for CIY MOVE 2022, but don't wait until the fundraiser to sign up for the trip. Start thinking now about odd jobs, birthday money and sending out support letters to family/friends to help with the expense of this event.

Are We Participating in Any Theme Days?

Yes! Who doesn't love a theme day?! Bring your favorite Hawaiian shirt & Christmas clothes! Pack for the fun. Also, appropriate costumes are always welcomed and encouraged.

How Much Money Should I Bring?

Enough for 4 travel meals, snacks & any additional purchase during travel or while at MOVE.

FCC Trip Code of Conduct:

- No possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco
- No foul language
- No students can drive
- No wrestling, fighting, weapons, fireworks, lighters, or explosives
- No boys in girls' sleeping quarters and no girls in boys' sleeping quarters
- Participation with the group is expected

- Respect property
- Respect one another, staff, and adult leaders
- Respect and comply with event schedules

MOVE RULES

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. No guys in girls' dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs and weapons are absolutely prohibited
4. Everyone must be in their dorms by the designated "In Dorm Time."
5. For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
7. During sessions, stay in your assigned seating. Please follow the posted seating chart.
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
9. Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes!
10. Do not move furniture as you will be charged for any assessed damage.
11. Do not dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
12. Absolutely no fireworks at any time during MOVE or while on campus property.
13. No food deliveries of any kind to the campus.
14. Students may leave campus ONLY with adult supervision; those staying behind must have an adult present.
15. Follow the dress guidelines.
